On Tuesday 4 March 2008, during the Slovenian Presidency of the EU, the Assembly of WEU is organising a colloquy, in cooperation with the Slovenian National Assembly, on **'2008: a decisive year for the Western Balkans'** in Ljubljana. A draft programme is attached for your information.

Given the prime importance of the subject, we are inviting substantial delegations from European and regional parliaments to take part, together with representatives from government and academia. We expect some 200 participants.
